The Next Step

Is this your child's final year at Primary School? As parents, we can help prepare them with the move to secondary school.

Trevor Lawn, head teacher at Alec Hunter Academy in Braintree explains what we can do to help...

It is well documented that some of the most stressful times in all of our lives occur when we make a transition. Taking on a new job, moving house, starting a family - all are fraught with concerns and uncertainties, and the same is very true in education. Whether it is the anxiety around starting school, moving into the juniors, or taking the step up from primary to secondary school, the prospect of settling into a new routine, in unfamiliar surroundings with different teachers can be a daunting one. However, whilst the youngsters themselves may sometimes be hesitant or slightly disorientated at these points, in my experience as a secondary Headteacher, they are, on the whole, more excited by new experiences and challenges than us cautious adults. As a result, it is usually the parents who are far more agitated about their children joining us in Year 7, and whom I do my best to reassure.

So what can we do as parents to equip our children suitably for the demands of secondary school life? Well, the summer holidays are, of course, a fabulous opportunity for relaxation and recharging of batteries, but they also offer opportunities to broaden horizons and expand your child's range of cultural experiences. I am often shocked, in conversation with our students after the long, 6 week break, to discover that a few have not taken part in any structured activity or excursions at all throughout this period, and this can leave them somewhat restricted in class discussions since their reference points are limited. Many museums, exhibitions and galleries offer free admission, but there is just as much to be gained from a visit to a country park, a historical monument or a picnic in a previously undiscovered part of this picturesque county.

Both the primary and secondary curriculum have changed in recent years, with increased emphasis on higher level literacy skills and much more demanding content appearing



in GCSE syllabuses across all subjects. More than ever, children need to expose themselves to a range of reading material to broaden their vocabulary and command of language. Rather than recommending any particular texts, since there are so many to choose from and this should largely be guided by personal interest, I would propose instead imposing restrictions on games console time throughout the holidays, since this can easily eat up whole days if there are no agreed quotas. Simply by insisting that there is a 'gadget-free window' which must be utilised for quiet reading every day as part of the holiday routine, good habits may be established which can be sustained once term recommences.

It is natural, particularly for parents whose eldest child is joining secondary school, to feel obliged to purchase lots of equipment in readiness for the range of lessons ahead. Our Year 7s often arrive clutching pencil cases bulging with all manner of multicoloured pens, geometry sets and other random stationery items, many of which are completely unnecessary. In this (pencil?) case, less is frequently more. Invest in some good quality rollerball or handwriting pens that will help to keep work looking neat and professional, some pencils and basic items such as a ruler, rubbers and sharpeners. Above all, make sure your child has some kind of container for these

materials; it is the children who carry their entire world around in their pockets who are most susceptible to losing things.

Whilst I have concentrated heavily on how parents can help their children to prepare for secondary life, there is a far more important role, in my view, for mums and dads to play once term gets under way. With a timetable containing different lessons every day, including some practical subjects, such as PE and Technology, which may require special equipment, the additional organisational demands on our 11 year olds are considerable. Moreover, there will be homework from a range of subjects, each with varying deadlines to be met. It takes some time for most youngsters to adjust to these challenges, but there is no doubt that this process is smoother where parents are playing a very active part in establishing the evening routine of checking that homework is complete and the bag is packed with the right books and resources. Each child's ability to do this independently will develop over time, but a guiding hand is certainly beneficial in those early months.

There is no magic formula for ensuring that students adjust well to secondary school. We all try to play our part, both in school and within the family, to facilitate this, but it is hard to foresee and eliminate every possible obstacle to success that they may encounter. This is why the most useful thing that all parents can do is to encourage their children to be resilient, to take the rough with the smooth, to enjoy success and not to be crushed by setbacks but to learn from them. If they can approach their secondary education with this mindset, they will undoubtedly emerge to face the world as fully-formed and resplendent butterflies.


